

**PUBLIC NOTICE TO MEMBERS OF THE

**SECTION 251 - THE *MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT***

**TAKE NOTICE** that the Commission of the Trivillage Regional Sewage Services Commission of Alberta Beach, in the Province of Alberta, has given first reading to borrowing By-law No. 10-2016 which will, upon final passage and approval, authorize the proper officers of the said Trivillage Regional Sewage Services Commission to borrow monies from the Alberta Capital Finance Authority by way of debenture issue, to pay for the cost of rebuilding the six lift stations (within/outside) the limits of the said Commission;

The total cost of the aforesaid project amounts to \$2,000,000.00. The amount to be borrowed on the credit and security of the Commission by the issue of debentures is \$2,000,000.00. The debentures are to be repayable to the Alberta Capital Finance Authority in fifty (50) equal consecutive semi-annual instalments of combined principal and interest, the semi-annual interest not to exceed three per centum (3%), or the interest rate as fixed from time to time by the Alberta Capital Finance Authority;

**NOW THEREFORE NOTICE** is hereby given by the Commission of the Trivillage Regional Sewer Services Commission that, unless a petition of the members for a vote on By-law No. 10-2016 is demanded, as provided for by the terms of Section 231 of the *Municipal Government Act*, the said Commission may pass the said borrowing by-law.

All persons interested are hereby notified and they are required to govern themselves accordingly.

## INFORMATION FOR ELECTORS

Pursuant to Section 1(i) of the *Municipal Government Act* an "elector" means:

1. A person who is eligible to vote in the election for a councillor under the *Local Authorities Election Act*.

Pursuant to section 47(1) of the *Local Authorities Election Act* a person is eligible to vote in an election if he:

- a) is at least 18 years old,
- b) is a Canadian citizen, and
- c) has resided in Alberta for the 6 consecutive months immediately preceding election day and is resident in the area on election day.

A poll may be demanded in the Village of Alberta Beach, the Summer Village of Sunset Point, and the Summer Village of Val Quentin by electors equal in number to at least

- a) in the case of a municipality other than a summer village, by electors of the municipality equal in number to at least 10% of the population and
- b) in the case of a summer village, by 10% of the electors of the summer village

in accordance with the provisions of section 223 of the *Municipal Government Act* and in accordance with the provisions of section 251 of the *Municipal Government Act*.

The petition for a vote must be received by the Chief Administrative Officer within 15 days of the last publication of this notice and shall contain on each page "an accurate and identical statement of the purpose of the petition". (Further requirements of the petition are provided in section 224 of the *Municipal Government Act*.)

DATE of the last publication of this notice is the 20<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2016.
